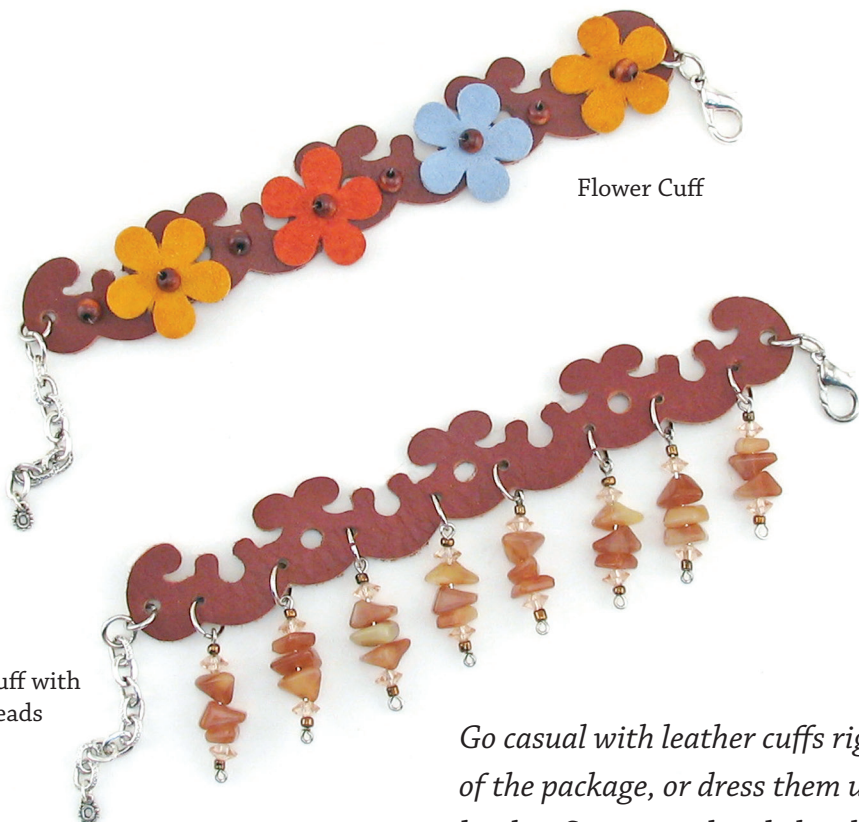


# REALEATHER<sup>®</sup> Jewelry

## Embellished Lacy Cuffs Designed by Nancy Anderson



Flower Cuff

*Go casual with leather cuffs right out of the package, or dress them up with leather flowers or dangly beads!*

## Instructions

### Materials

#### For Each Cuff

##### • *Realeather*™ Jewelry:

Lacy Leather Cuff with clasps\*, tan (J7005-03)

#### For Flower Cuff

##### • *Realeather*™ Jewelry:

- 4 Suede Flowers, colors of choice (J7046-08)
- 8 small (6mm) brown beads
- 24" length of monofilament (clear cord)

#### For Cuff with Beads

- 16 small (seed) copper beads
- 16 small (5mm) salmon-color saucer crystal beads
- 24 medium (6-8mm) light brown chips gemstones
- 8 large (8mm) silver jump rings
- 12 head pins or eye pins (2" length)  
(Use eye pins if you plan to later add charms to dangles)
- Round nose pliers
- Wire cutter
- Ruler

#### For Flower Cuff

**1)** Cut a 24" length of invisible cord. Place *Realeather*™ Cuff on table with short scallops along bottom. Thread cord up from underneath Cuff, through second hole from left, leaving a 2" end. (First hole has jump ring with closure.) Thread cord through one bead and back down into same hole (Photo A). Tightly pull to secure. On back, tightly knot cord three times, leaving both ends long for now. Bead will be in place on front.

**2)** On back, bring cord up through third hole, through one *Realeather*™ Suede Flower, through a bead, back down through Flower and hole (Photo B). Tightly pull to secure. Before going to next hole, insert the cord through the last "stitch" on back (Photo C). Pull to secure.

**3)** Continue working left to right, adding a bead or a *Realeather*™ Flower and bead at each hole for a total of four Flowers. At the other end, knot cord three times. Trim end to 2", go back to a previous hole, tie several times to secure and trim end. Repeat with end of cord at other end of Cuff.

#### For Cuff with Beads

**1)** String onto eye pin, beads as follows: seed, saucer, three chip gemstones, saucer and seed. Use wire cutter to trim headpin 3/8" from last bead. Use pliers to bend pin at 90-degree angle and then into a single loop (Photo D). Repeat to make a total of eight dangles.

**2)** Place *Realeather*™ Cuff on table with short scallops along bottom. Use pliers to open one jump ring, string it through second hole from left. (First hole has jump ring with closure.) Add one dangle to jump ring and close it. Repeat for a total of eight dangles hanging from jump rings.

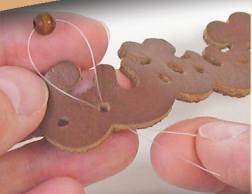
